## Hydrangea Necklace

Press Hydrangea and coat with resin to make flower accessories.

### <Material>

- UV-LED Resin "Star Drop" hard
- Hydrangea
- Rhinestone
- Pearl beads
- Chain
- Round jump ring
- Accessory parts

### <Tool>

- UV-LED handy light
- Mixing stick
- Pin Vise
- Clear sheet
- Pliers
- Dry sheet
- Weight book

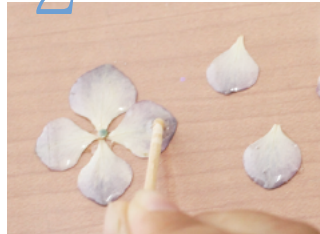

Refer to the instruction below, make the pressed flowers with rose petals.

2



Place the pressed flowers on a clear sheet. Drop resin on each sepal and spread it to go outside the edge of the sepal with a toothpick. Cure the sepal in a minute.

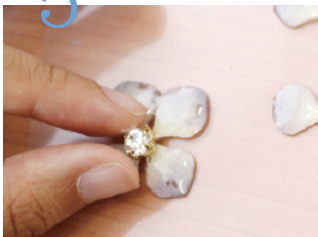
Shape the sepal with scissors.

4



Turn the sepal over and repeat the step 2 & 3.

5



Glue a rhinestone on the center of the sepal flower.

6



Fill the interstices between sepals and rhinestone with resin. Cure again in a minute.

7



Make a small hold on it with pin vise.

8



Connect it to the chain with round jump rings.

### How to press flowers in a book.

#### • absorbent paper

Press the flowers between two absorbent pieces of paper, and then flatten with a heavy book. Wait 5 - 7 days for flowers to dry completely.

### How to make dried flowers using the microwave.

#### • Silica gel

Place fresh flowers in a microwave-safe container (face up) and add silica gel in and around the petals until fully covered.

Do not cover the container with plastic wrap.

Put the container in a 500W microwave for 60-90 seconds. Allow to completely dry and remove from the gel gently with tweezers.
